Dear Robert and Family:



In 2013, when Oberbürgermeister Jung presented Frank with *das Goldene Kleeblatt*, I wrote him that after all he had done over nearly 40 years to bring together former residents of Fürth and Nürnberg and re-establish a sense of community among them, he was certainly overdue for the honor.
